Aperitif

Dolín Vermouth de Chambéry - Using the same recipe since 1821, Dolín is the sole independent company still producing Vermouth de Chambéry & has long been the benchmark for fine vermouth. Made with fine wines & botanicals found in Alpine meadows, it has a fresh, restrained & elegant nose, with a subtle, complex & bittersweet palate that finishes with a note of hazelnut. A delicious aperitif on ice with lemon or mixed with sparkling water. 8.

Sparklers

We use Cava Avinyo Brut (NV) from Penedes, Spain

Wild Hibiscus Mimosa - A spectacular crown-shaped edible Wild Hibiscus flower gradually opens in the bottom of your champagne flute as the bubbles rise around it. 9.

Rose Hibiscus Mimosa - The same spectacular edible Wild Hibiscus flower flavored with Bulgarian rose oil that adds an exciting floral note to an already fantastic party in a glass. 10.

Champagne Cocktail - With a sugar cube soaked in Angostura Bitters dropped into the glass. 8.

Classic Bellini - With puréed peaches. 9.

Pineapple Bellini - Fresh pineapple purée. 9.

Classic Mimosa - With fresh-squeezed orange juice. 8.

Shandy - This refresher is made with Upland Brewery's Wheat Ale, mixed with pink lemonade. Fruity & delicious!! 5.

Kiddie Wild Hibiscus Mimosa - A spectacular crown-shaped edible Wild Hibiscus flower gradually opens in the bottom of your glass as the soda bubbles rise around it. 5.

Sake Cocktails

Made with Tozai 'Living Jewel' Junmai Sake

Bloody Mary - We make our own mix & garnish with lime, celery & olives.

Screw Driver - Made with our fresh squeezed orange juice.

Featured Beers

Arctic Panzer Wolf - Dry and stupendously hopped, this massive IPA that will leave your palate its hapless victim. Arctic Panzer Wolf has superior aromas of marmalade, white wine, pine and apricot, all mixed with an intense American hop bitterness.

Upland Brewery's Infinite Wisdom - A strong Belgian-style Ale that has a long fermentation period using classic Belgian yeasts. Its nose contains some banana and citrus notes with a complex fruitiness that envelops your tongue with a light warming sensation upon tasting.

Bubbles

Tarlant QV 'Discobitch' Champagne - A wine as cool as its name. All 2005 Reserve juice, an equal blend of Chard, Pinot Noir, & Pinot Meunier. Early bottling captures the freshness & approachability, while still providing the layers of a serious beverage. *Extravagance et émotions, le Champagne de la fête par excellence, qui accompagne toutes les créations et les cocktails de folie...* Extravagance & emotions, the Champagne celebration par excellence, which accompanies all the creations, & the cocktail of madness b: 95.

Cava Avinyo Brut (Penedes, Spain NV) - A clean, brisk, mineral nose offers scents of toast, citrus, & green apple. The apple flavor is nicely braced by juicy acids, & the finish shows finesse & complexity. g: 7. b: 26.

CTR Reginato Celestina Rose of Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina (2008)) - This is a wine that is hard not to love! A deep, vibrant, almost red hue that has an equally concentrated palate. Crisp, dry & delicately tannic, it encompasses the ripe berry character of Malbec without sacrificing its lightness. This is a wine that can take you through your entire meal! g: 9. b: 32.

Black Chook Sparkling Shiraz (McLaren Vale, Australia NV) - A gorgeous sparkler that shows wonderfully smooth ripe juicy berries with a rich weighty texture across the palate. A luscious bubbly wine destined to compliment any occasion. g: 9. b: 32.

Wild Hibiscus Mimosa - A spectacular crown-shaped edible Wild Hibiscus flower gradually opens in the bottom of your champagne flute as the bubbles of Cava Avinyo Brut rise around it. Looks like a party in a glass. g: 9.

Classic Mimosa - A lovely combination of Cava Avinyo Brut & fresh squeezed orange juice. Makes for a sunny morning even on the dreariest of days. g: 8.

White

Pares Balta Blanc de Pacs (Penedes/Catalonia, Spain 2009) - An organic wine with an aroma dominated by mature white fruits like pear & apple covering a light floral background. Fresh with nice acidity. Soft with a lovely, breezy finish. b: 35.

A to Z Wineworks Pinot Gris (Newberg, Oregon 2009) - With aromas of ripe & lush citrus fruits, this wine is framed with classic rich Oregon Pinot Gris proportions & lift. The finish rolls seamlessly off the mid-palate & goes on & on. g: 7. b: 26.

Joseph Hofstätter Pinot Grigio (Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy 2009) - A classic & very expressive Pinot Grigio with scents of citrus, peach, melon, & pear. Well-structured & direct on the palate with a tangy, fruity, acidic finish. b: 45.

Seven Hills Riesling (Columbia Valley, Washington 2009) - A graceful, balanced Riesling with moderate alcohol & brilliant straw color. Abundant, lime, green apple, & mineral notes softened by white peach. g: 8. b: 30.

More White

Le Grand Ballon Sauvignon Blanc (Loire Valley, France 2009) - Delaunay is the perfect combination of modern technique and long-lived traditions. Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc, this wine has refreshingly light floral aromas. Crisp and vibrant on the palate with light citrus fruit flavors & good acidity, it finishes very dry with a grassy note. g: 9. b: 32.

Robert Talbott Vineyards Logan Chardonnay (Monterey County, California 2008) - Intensely flavored, complex, fruit-forward, & food-friendly. Exhibits lush tropical flavors, excellent concentration, citrus acidity, & wonderful balance...all hallmarks of Chardonnay from Monterey County. g: 12. b: 38.

Foxglove Chardonnay (San Miguel, California 2009) - Outrageously delicious Chardonnay showing plenty of white currant, pineapple, & tangerine skin notes that are surprisingly complex & rich with great zestiness. g: 9. b: 32.

Buxy Bourgogne Blanc (Côte Chalonnaise, France 2008) - Pleasing to the eye with the radiance of pure sunshine. Starts off right & doesn't miss a step. Willingly offers a pretty fragrance of acacia flower, lemon cream, summer apples, & pure, unfettered Chardonnay fruit. The aromatic profile follows through on the palate, leaving the mouth clean, refreshed, & eager for more. b: 40.

Patz & Hall Dutton Ranch Chardonnay, Russian River Valley (Sonoma County, California 2008) - Graceful & sophisticated, perfect for pairing with an array of foods. The aromas sing with old-vine heirloom clone fruit & enticing notes of crisp green apple, kiwi, peach, & pineapple. It continues on the palate with cleansing acidity & appealing mineral notes. To underscore its purity & elegant structure, this wine was crafted using 40 percent new oak. b: 65

Rosé

Crios de Susanna Balboa Rose of Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina 2009) - A beautiful, deep, vibrant color with a surprising amount of body for a rosé. The glorious aromas of ripe wild strawberries & cherries rush the palate complemented by spice & a clean dry finish. g: 7. b: 26.

Red

Elk Cove Vineyards Pinot Noir (Willamette Valley, Oregon 2008) - Deep red with a bright rim. Pure but subdued aromas of blackcurrant, cherry pit, & rose petal. Juicy & penetrating while tight & even. Austere, hinting at musky dark fruits & succulent herbs. b: 60.

Terra Andina Reserva Pinot Noir (Santiago, Chile 2009) -- A seductive & complex combination of black cherry & raspberry aromas, rose petals & violets, mingled with a soft touch of vanilla & coconut. Full-bodied & rich, with a soft & velvety texture, smooth tannins, & an elegant aftertaste. g: 8. b: 30.

More Red

Hey Mambo Sultry Red (Napa Valley, California 2008) -- This is a proprietary blend that oozes cool. Like the transformation from Norma Jean to Marilyn Monroe, the wine's girl-next-door aromas: cherry pie, root beer, caramel, & vanilla become a sultry starlet wrapped in crimson toile on the palate. Intense pomegranate, black cherry, cola, & dark chocolate flavors emerge with a hint of clove & rich espresso. This is dancing wine. g: 8. b: 30.

Lan Rioja Reserva (La Rioja, Spain 2005) - A hard shell of tannins cracks to offer sweet dried cherry & dark chocolate flavors. Intense & vibrant with accents of cranberry, rhubarb & mineral. It's powerful, yet remains light on its feet. b: 50.

La Posta 'Cocina' Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina 2008) - Vibrant color with the aromas of red cherries, raspberries, & violets mingling with spice notes, & a hint of soft caramel on the finish. A well-structured wine that is incredibly full of life. g: 9. b: 32.

Ben Marco Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina 2008) - This beautiful, deep purple wine comes from Susanna Balbo's sustainably-farmed vineyards & is full of perfumed aromas of ripe red fruits & roasted coffee beans. It's lush & full-bodied with loads of chewy, caramely, currant jam flavors & bright acidity with a touch of grip on the almost savory finish. b: 55.

Woop Woop Shiraz (McLaren Vale, Australia 2008) -- Deep in color with great intensity, bursting with blackberry fruit juice, blueberry jam, & masses of clean varietal Shiraz fruit. Well balanced with black licorice, pepper, & spice giving it tremendous flavor & length. g: 7. b: 26.

Wine Guerrilla Zinfandel (Sonoma County, California 2009) - Lovely in the mouth with bright, jammy berry fruits, & just enough of an edge to keep you coming back for more... (& more). g: 9. b: 32.

Leese-Fitch Cabernet Sauvignon (Sonoma County, California 2009) - The color of dark rubies, this Cabernet presents itself with a nose of bourbon-soaked cherries, chocolate, & cedar, complemented by red currants, blackberry cobbler flavors, & subtle notes of walnuts, wild game, & rich French oak. g: 7. b: 26.

Three Saints Cabernet Sauvignon (Santa Ynez Valley, California 2006) - Extraordinarily complex aromas of pipe tobacco, sandalwood, & wild briar brush are freshened by Santa Cruz blackberry & violet notes, framed by fine-grained tannins & a cleansing finish. On the palate, the wine is firm, fresh & striking. b: 40.

Steltzner Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap District (Napa Valley, California 2006) - Ripe fruit & integrated tannins provide excellent structure. Flavors lean toward cherry & blackberry kissed with a hint of smokiness carried over from the nose, followed by a finish that's smoother than smooth. b: 75.

Sun King Brewery Sunlight Cream Ale (Indianapolis, IN) - Sun King's most approachable beer that has a smooth malt profile & a crisp, clean finish. Silver Medal Winner, 2010 World Beer Cup. 5.75

Upland's Wheat Ale (Bloomington, IN) - Award-winning classic rendition of a Belgian wit. Light on the tongue & easy going. Made with 50% wheat malt & spiced with coriander & Curacao orange peel. 4.25

Paulaner Hefe-Weizen (Munich, Germany) - Full scents of bananas, citrus, & bubblegum. Crisp with a little spice to balance out the sweetness, this Hefe-Weizen is seriously easy to drink 4.75

Boulevard Single Wide IPA (Kansas City, Missouri) - An American version IPA that boasts a heady combination of six hop varieties, yet is well-balanced with a crisp, dry finish. Its flowery aroma has hints of citrus & fresh mown hay. 4.75

Bells Two-Hearted Ale (Kalamazoo, Michigan) - India Pale Ale style well suited for Hemingwayesque trips to the Upper Peninsula. American malts & enormous hop additions give this beer a crisp finish & incredible floral hop aroma. 5.25

Upland's Rad Red Amber Ale (Bloomington, Indiana) - This American Amber Ale has a malty almond/chocolate taste laced with a lush spicy hop flavor. Creamy body combined with robust maltiness makes this a satisfying beer indeed. 4.25

Rogue Dead Guy Ale (Newport, Oregon) - A German-style Maibock made with Rogue's proprietary 'PacMan' yeast. It's deep honey in color with a rich malty aroma & a well-balanced finish. Gratefully dedicated to the Rogue in all of us. 4.75

Sun King Brewery Wee Mac (Indianapolis, Indiana) - Scottish-style brown ale fermented at cooler than normal temperatures to mimic the climate of Scotland. So easy to drink, with a nice hazelnut character & rich toffee undertones. Gold Medal Winner, 2010 World Beer Cup 5.75

Xingu Black (Santa Maria, Brazil) - This is an unexpectedly smooth lager with a surprisingly light & fruity flavor. The black roasted malt gives a pleasant & complex taste to this truly unique beer imported from exotic Brazil. 5.95
